



APPRENTICESHIP READINESS

Right now, more than 50% of all candidates fail the Alberta Apprenticeship Entrance Exam. This is the reason that NAIT developed its new Apprenticeship Readiness (AR) program.

This intensive program will help prospective apprentices brush up on their math, science, computer literacy and communications. As well as the academic training, students will also learn practical jobsite skills and be certified in four fundamental industrial safety courses. Graduates will be ready to step confidently into their first year as apprentices with solid job readiness and safety skills.

To allow students the flexibility to continue working, classes run on seven non-consecutive weekends, with both in-class and online components.
